

OUT-OF-SCHOOL ADVENTURES

Campers will explore Barr Lake State Park for bald eagle spotting, hiking, and archery before visiting Rocky Mountain Arsenal Wildlife Refuge to look for prairie dogs and bison, then return to camp for pick-up.
